

Check for Backup Completion

Whether a message has been received indicating that the backup process had an error or the user just wants to check on a backups progress. The following **DSPLOG** command should be used. Type **DSPLOG** followed by the **F4** function key. Change only the **Beginning Time** (time of the backup) and the **Beginning Date**. Use the date and time format as listed below. Remember to use the 24 hour clock for the time. Once the date and time of the backup has been entered press enter.

You will be presented with the following screen or something similar. First press **F10** function key. Press Page Up or Page Down to find the line **Job 130086/QSYSOPR/QEZBKTMxxx**. Following that line should be a list of libraries that were backed up. Check for either library: **ACSDTA201 (RIS data library) or OS36FV5 (OIS data library)**.

If either library **ACSDTA201 (RIS data library) or OS36FV5 (OIS data library)** does not appear in the list of libraries that were backed up then you should call **SolutionWare**. Occasionally a few objects are “Not Saved” from library **ACSDTA201 or OS36FV5**. That will happen from time to time and it is nothing to be alarmed about.
