

# iSeries WorkStation Reset

Should the workstation that you are working on lose power or otherwise get disconnected. Take the following steps to reset the workstation(s).

First, make sure the workstation(s) are all physically connected and that they are powered ON!!!

**\*\*\* Should the job that you were running be a critical job, such as a Close or Post, please call SolutionWare before running this process.**

Sign on to the iSeries with the appropriate authority.

1. Type: **WRKUSRJOB USER(username) STATUS(\*ACTIVE)** and press Enter
  - a. Substitute your user id. for the word username
  - b. If the display states "No jobs to display" then skip this step.
  - c. Place a "4" to the left of the workstation(s) that need to be reset and press F4. When the "End Job" screen comes up type "\*immed" on the "How to end" line and press Enter.
    - i. Refresh the screen by pressing the F5 key until the workstation(s) no longer display in the list.
  
2. Type: **wrkcfgsts \*dev workstation\*** and press Enter
  - a. Substitute the first couple of characters of your workstation id. for the word workstation and place an asterisk after the workstation id.
  - b. Place a "2" to the left of the workstation(s) that need to be reset and press enter.
    - i. Press F5 until the workstation(s) go to a "VARIED OFF" status.
  - c. Place a "1" to the left of the workstation(s) that need to be reset and press enter.
    - i. Press F5 until the workstation(s) go to a "VARIED ON" or "VARY ON PENDING" status.

The workstation(s) should now be available for use.
